Mobile Home Handrails, Guardrails & Steps

- 1. Stairway clearance shall not be less than 36 inches in width.
- 2. Stairways risers (rise) shall not be greater than 7-3/4 inch
- 3. Stairway treads (run) shall be a minimum of 10 inches
- 4. The length of treads and the height of risers shall not vary more than 3/8 of an inch.
- 5. Riser openings shall not exceed 4 inches between the treads
- 6. Where the top of the guard also serves as a handrail on the open side of a stairway, the top shall be no less than 34 inches and no more than 38 inches above the edge of the treads.
- 11. Stringers shall be positively anchored to the primary self-supporting structure to resist lateral and vertical forces.
- 12. If one side of the stairway is solid (example: wall of the structure, etc.), guardrails are only required on the open side. Otherwise, guardrails are required on both sides
- 13. Continuous graspable handrails are required on at least one side.
